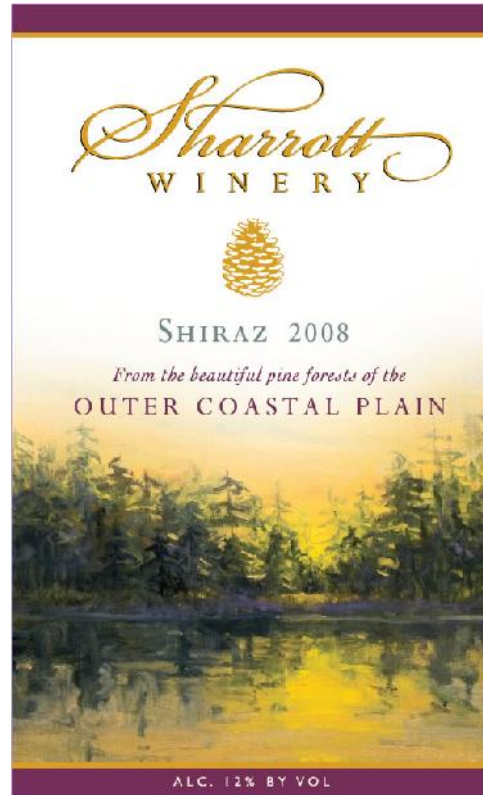

Production/Fermentation Technique & Description:

Our Shiraz is cool-fermented then aged in American Oak barrels to maintain the fruit flavors of this grape thought to be originally from the Northern Rhone region of France. While Shiraz from the Rhone in France can be robust yet velvety and delicate Shiraz is famed in Australia and California for being big and bold. New Jersey Shiraz lies somewhere, stylistically, in between. Our 2008 Shiraz is medium-bodied with hints of black cherry, vanilla and black pepper that has a balanced, peppery finish.
